Effective Wednesday, July 21, the New Mexico Technology Access Program is participating in a trial of BrowseAloud, an Assistive Technology solution which enables websites to speak.

BrowseAloud is a unique solution which reads all accessible website content aloud in order to enhance the accessibility of online services and information centers. BrowseAloud is designed to assist the print disabled community, specifically anyone with mild visual impairments, learning difficulties, dyslexia or where English is a second language. Put simply, BrowseAloud works by the user moving their cursor around the page and having the content read aloud to them.

The solution is given away FREE to the end user and would be licensed by NMTAP for use with its website.
